

\$60 million will be used to restore key arterial roads

ABOUT \$60 million will be used to restore five key arterial roads between the Mackay City Centre and Paget Industrial Precinct.

Road networks to be restored include Paradise St, Bridge Rd, Juliet St, Archibald St roundabout and Shakespeare St.

With the roads experiencing heavy traffic flow during the week delays are expected while the work is completed.

Roads and Drainage councillor Kevin Casey said the rehabilitation would be carried out over the next 16 months - projects will be starting and finished at different times.

The first project to get underway is Bridge Rd between Milton and Paradise Sts with work starting this week to ensure completion before sports season in March.

Traffic will be able to continue to travel in both directions during construction works, but access to Warland St from Bridge Rd will be limited with alternative access via Paradise or Milton Sts.
